I WILL NOT COMPROMISE

Compromise - accept standards that are lower than is desirable; to partially do what is right or expected; to do less than what is expected; partial obedience.

OK on nonessential things but never God's standards.

Compromise with the world:

- 1. Is a danger for even the most Godly of believers.
- 2. Requires discernment because of its' subtlety.
- 3. Almost always draws one in through wrong relationships.
 - a. marriage
 - b. social
 - c. spiritual
 - d. political
 - e. business
- 4. It brings disastrous results.

AVOID COMPROMISE

- 1. Live with an awareness of the Spirit's presence 1 Cor. 3:16, 17
- 2. Live with an awareness of sin's power Rom. 7:18; Gal. 5:9.
- 3. Esteem God's precepts as right about all things Ps.119:128 and give your highest loyalty to Truth 2 Cor. 13:8
- 4. Realize it is impossible to have both the acceptance of the world and the approval of God James 4:4
- 5. Ponder or think about the end of a thing not the beginning Pr.4:26
- 6. Know there are certain things God is intolerant of and is very narrow minded about Acts 4:12; Jn. 1:5
- 7. Be aware that our compromise will affect others not just ourselves.

BEWARE OF COMPROMISE

Joshua 9

The Lord's Command – Make no covenant Ex. 23:20-24, 32, 33;

Ex. 34:10-16; Deut. 7:1-5

- 1. The enemy & deceivers usually make the first move
- 2. They use partial truths
- 3. They are usually good with words & disguising their intentions
- 4. They usually offer something that is of personal benefit to you
- 5. They get you to operate naturally and emotionally
- 6. Joshua compromised because he was deceived by appearances
- 7. Discovery is often too late.
- 8. Some recovery is possible although you may live with the effects
