- A. Lev. 23:7-14 The Feast of Firstfruits (Deut. 26:1-11)
- B. Religious public meetings (holy convocations) consecrated to religious observances. A "holy day," we get the word "holiday."

II. Our Holiday would not have happened without this

- A. 2 Corinthians 6:17, 18; 1 Peter 2:11; 1 Cor. 15:33, 34
- B. To mark off from others by boundaries; to limit; exclude
 - 1. Learn to view sin as God does
 - 2. Does your fellowship/association encourage change or disobedience
 - 3. What purpose, pursuit, or destiny is being supported
 - 4. You are not extreme but being Scriptural Gal. 5:9 "a little leaven."
 - 5. Will your association undermine the stand of an authority
 - 6. Will your fellowship lead to defiling or searing your conscience
 - 7. Separation is done out of love not hate, frustration, or meanness
